<p>Week 1 June 4 – 8</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">“Astronaut Adventures”</p> <p>Far Out Art: Campers will work on set and prop design for their drama production. They will also create space themed art projects.</p> <p>Interstellar Broadcast: Campers will study acting for the stage while exploring the wonders of space travel and create and perform a short play.</p> <p>Ready, Set, Launch! Campers will perform various activities, and will learn about physical, mental, and social wellness using our theme of space. We will do this using team building exercises as well as individual exercises.</p> <p><i>Field Trips</i> 1st-4th: Playmakers (or similar) 5th-7th: Lafayette Science Museum(or similar)</p>
<p>Week 2 June 11 – 15</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">“Reach for the Stars”</p> <p>Dancing with the Stars: Campers will learn simple choreography and will dance like they’re the stars in the night sky! We will also read literature associated with dance and the stars.</p> <p>Earthy Artists: Lower grades- I will read “How to catch a star” and we will create watercolor art using watercolor paints, tape resist and medicine droppers. Upper Grades–Campers will learn about pointillism and will create starry art using pointillism techniques!</p> <p>Reading/Writing/Readers Theater: Campers will engage in reading and dramatizing an exciting book. Campers will learn through hands on activities to capture their thoughts and creative writing skills.</p> <p><i>Field Trips</i> LSU Mars Truck (or similar)</p>
<p>Week 3 June 18 – 22</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">“Planets Here, Planets There, Planets Everywhere!”</p> <p>Dancing with the Planets!: They will learn simple choreography and will dance like they’re on another planet!</p> <p>Earthy Artists: Lower Grades-We will read “The Planets in Our Solar System” by Franklyn Branley and campers will create a Solar System Hat using glow in the dark paint. Upper Grades-We will view a video from National Geographic Kids called “13 Planet” and campers will create Planet Solar System Art using pastels and pastel chalk.</p> <p>Agent Planeteers: Campers will have fun through role play acting out word problems.</p> <p><i>Field Trips</i> 1st-4th: LASM (or similar) 5th-7th: Planetarium in Kenner, LA (or similar)</p>
<p>Week 4 June 25 – 29</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">“Blast Off!”</p> <p>Reading is Out of This World: Campers will read children’s fiction with a space theme and non-fiction about space, learn about famous art, engage in creative writing, and cooking projects.</p> <p>Cosmic Cadets: Campers will use their own creative minds and math skills to build and design a rocket while learning about place value and numbers.</p> <p>Astro Fit: Campers will engage in physical activities that utilize the same body parts/systems as astronauts do in training and on missions in space.</p> <p><i>Field Trips</i> 1st-4th: LASM (different than previous week) (or similar) 5th-7th: Infinity Space Center in MS (or similar)</p>
